PLAYING RIGHTS OF FIVE AND A HALF DAY MEMBERS

PLAYING TIMES

The current restrictions on the playing times for five and a half day members are as follows:-

1. Monday to Friday inclusive with the exception of Bank Holidays (see Note a).
2. Sunday afternoon after 12.30 p.m. except where the Course is closed for a 36 hole competition. In practice this means as soon as the formal morning's event has cleared the course, but this must be checked with the Professional, who has responsibility as the Official Starter, and will inform you of the exact time.
3. Any of the five charity competitions run on Saturdays, provided you have an official Royston Golf Club handicap, by entering the competition and paying the appropriate entrance fee. You should also note that in the case of the Hospital Cup, any person whether a member or not may enter, PROVIDED that they have an official handicap.

NOTE (a) - Five and a half day members may play on Saturdays or Bank Holidays but must pay half of the green fee and avoid playing at busy times or when a competition is in progress which they are not entitled to enter. Effectively you are signing yourself in.

SIGNING IN OF GUESTS

Only one guest qualifies for a reduced green fee, whether it is for a weekday or Sunday afternoon. Therefore if you are signing yourself in on these occasions to play with a non-member (i.e., a guest) he/she must then pay the full green fee. You may sign in more than one guest but in accordance with the above.

COMPETITIONS OPEN TO THOSE FIVE AND A HALF DAY MEMBERS WITH A HANDICAP

4. Thursday Medal - these are held (between daylight hours) normally on the third Thursday in the month.
5. Sunday Medal - these are usually held on the first Sunday in the month, but you may only play in these within your allocated time - see 2. above.
6. Northgrave Shield - this is open to all male members who have a handicap of 16 or greater. The competition is held during the summer months and you can enter as many cards as you wish. See the notice board for further details.

PLEASE OBSERVE THE RULES OF GOLF AND ETIQUETTE AT ALL TIMES
